EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES APPLICATION CENTRES TO BE HELD IN MID NORTH

RFCSSA (Rural Financial Counselling Service SA Inc) is to partner with PIRSA (Primary Industries and Resources SA) to host IRS (Interest Rate Subsidy) Information Sessions during late January and early February.

General Manager, Kay Matthias said that the sessions will be held to assist clients with their application for interest rate subsidy.

'This is an opportunity for people to ask any questions that they may have, as well as obtaining the right information about interest rate subsidy, get the necessary forms to complete the applications, and if required, assistance from a rural financial counsellor'.

'In addition to a rural financial counsellor, a PIRSA assessor will also attend some sessions.'

'No appointments are required. We are encouraging farmers and farm dependent small businesses to just drop in,' Ms Matthias said.

RFCSSA is encouraging people to attend the information sessions to make an early start on IRS applications to avoid the deadline of 31 March.
